## 78. WORD CHAIN

The four four-letter words BOOK, MARK, DOWN, and PLAY go together, in order, to form a cyclical chain of linking compound words: BOOKMARK, MARKDOWN, DOWNPLAY, and PLAYBOOK (the last compound linking the fourth word back to the first).
