As many of you are already aware, staff will be returning to school beginning June 1st. As is the case across the province, safety and the well-being of students and staff will be the priority for people when they are at Carberry Collegiate. While teachers will be communicating with students and parents to make plans, we wanted to provide everyone with the following information about accessing Carberry Collegiate.

- Teachers will be contacting students about times they can come to meet
- It is optional and at the discretion of parents/students as to whether they come in or not
- In most cases students will be scheduled a one-hour time slot
- In order to limit movement in the school student are asked to use the washroom prior to coming to the
- Upon arriving at the school students are asked to wait outside at the markings provided
- Staff will screen students and direct them to hand sanitizing station upon entry
- Students are asked to go directly to classrooms and leave school immediately after being dismissed.

The following are the designated entry points and times of access:

Northwest doors at 9:00AM, 10:30AM and 1:00PM Grade 5&6 Grade 7&8 students

Northeast doors at 9:15AM, 10:45AM and 1:15 PM

High School students Front doors at 9:30, 11:00 and 1:30PM

- Currently, busses are not running
- Students are welcome to bring and wear masks
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant for surfaces will be in every classroom
- Water Fountains/filling stations will not be available
- Students will be asked to clean out their lockers
- Please come to the school with the mindset of PHYSICAL DISTANCING (staying at least 2 meters away from others) and HAND WASHING/SANITIZING, as it remains key to limiting the spread.
